Working with the two Current Perspectives Co-Editors, the sub-editor will share primary responsibility for the Current Perspectives section of the Journal, reviewing all Current Perspectives to determine publication status. The sub-editor will contribute to decisions on the functioning of the Journal and encourage the contribution of scholarly work to the Journal, particularly but not limited to the Current Perspectives section.
